We had a few things going in our favor; first a pretty solid group of capable anglers; next was the Bighorn River itself and it's insane number of fish per mile. The guys hit it from 11 to 4:30 and we caught in the neighborhood of 200 fish, all brown trout. None of them were less than 15 in. It was unlike anything I have ever seen. We all agreed that our success was due to your **Otter's Soft Milking Eggs**. We had tried several egg patterns over the years but nothing get eaten like your Otter's Eggs!
