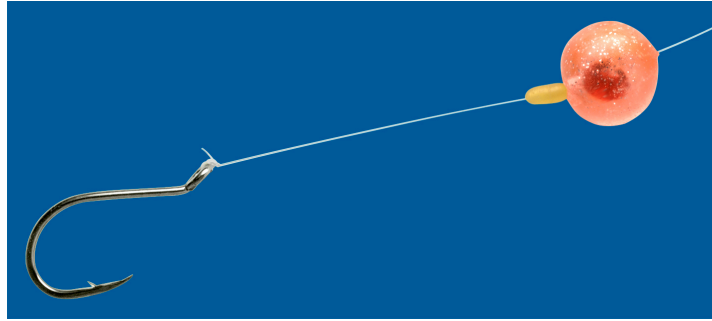


How to Peg an Otter Egg with a float stop



Pegged "Otter Egg " using a rubber float stop

Pegging an Otter Egg on the end of your *leader* with a rubber float stop:

1. Mount Otter Egg onto end of your leader by inserting mini egg threader end thru egg center and inserting 1 inch of leader end thru open loop on end of mini egg threader ;
2. Slide egg off mini egg threader onto leader and slide egg until it is on the single strand of leader.
3. Mount float stop onto leader by inserting one inch of leader end thru wire loop end holding the float stops;
4. Slide float stop off of wire onto leader until float stop is on the single strand of your leader.
5. Tie hook to end of leader below your mounted float stop and Otter Egg .
6. Slide float stop and egg to end of your leader, with egg 2" above your hook.

(Using a 3 X to 1 X leader helps prevent the float stops from sliding too easily)

Pegging an Otter Egg onto a 16"-24" *tippet* with a rubber float stop:

1. Tie your hook to one end of tippet.
2. Mount float stop onto tippet by inserting one inch of tippet end thru wire loop end, holding the float stops;
3. Slide float stop off of wire onto leader until float stop is on the single strand of your tippet.
4. Mount Otter Egg onto end of your tippet by inserting mini egg threader end thru egg center and insert 1 inch of tippet end thru open loop on end of mini egg threader ;
5. Slide egg off mini egg threader onto tippet and slide egg until it is on single strand of tippet.
5. Slide float stop and egg to end of your tippet, with egg 2" above your hook.
6. Tie tippet end to a micro swivel to tie onto your leader end, or tie nail knot with end of tippet to end of your leader.
